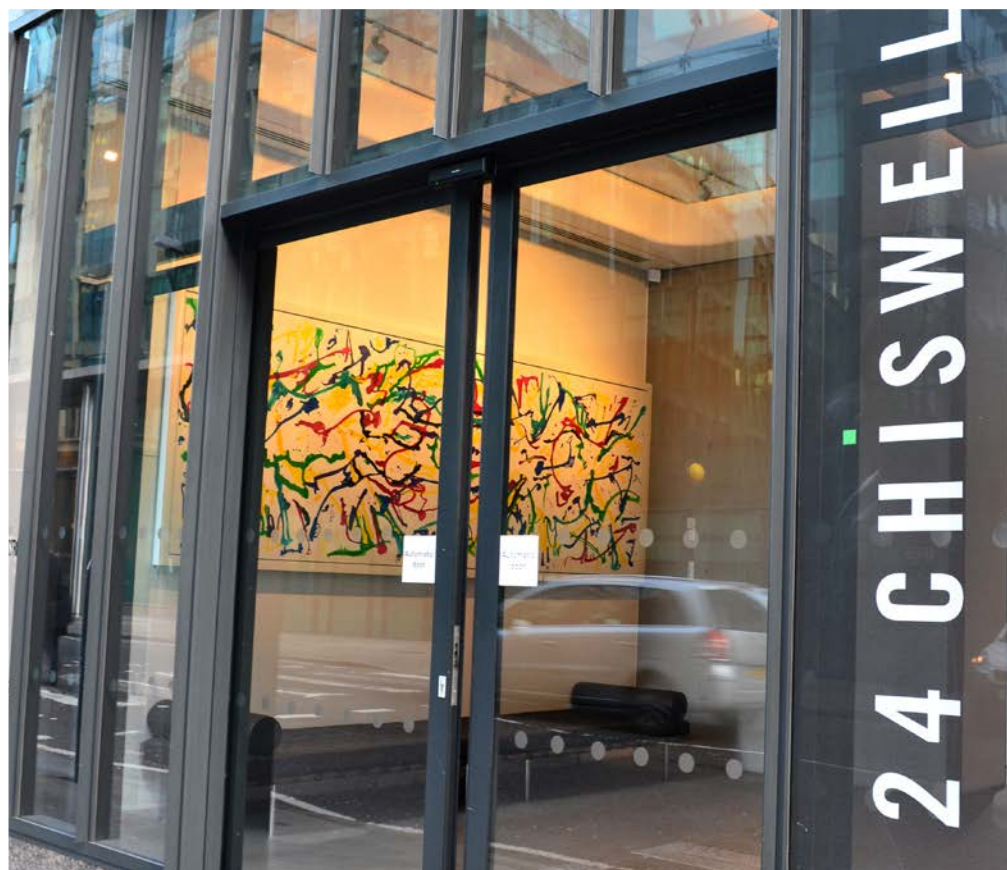


Discreet and seamless access to **24 Chiswell Street** in London



The building is located on the North side of Chiswell Street adjacent to the Honourable Artillery Grounds in the City of London and offers 31,351 square feet of creative and contemporary grade A office space.

IMA Architects were asked to develop a scheme for the refurbishment of 24 Chiswell Street, which at the time was a 1990 office with multiple tenancies and ground floor retail.

The new reception was totally transformed by dropping it down to street level approximately 1m, however to access the 1st floor would only be via staircase.

Our distributor Access Lifts contacted Stepless by Guldmann in order to create a solution that would be discreet and designed to blend in seamlessly with the existing setting to maintain an attractive architectural appearance.

The Stepless Model C platform lift is a bespoke model designed for embedding in a flight of stairs or steps, with a platform at the upper level.

The platform lift is an excellent solution for use in a wide variety of places where users need to negotiate a difference in height. As the same material is used for the platform surface as for

the other steps or stairs the solution becomes a neat, barely noticeable part of the environment, irrespective of whether the original steps or stairs are made of stone, tile or wood.

This bespoke Stepless Model C was tailored to fit the staircase, and the safety shield was designed to fit the 1120 mm wide staircase.

This model is activated via a radio controlled fob available at request from the reception desk, where it can be operated by the users themselves or by their helpers, after they have been shown how to use it.
